OVERVIEW The irresistible family musical about the trials and triumphs of Joseph, Israel's favorite son, gets the SVST treatment! The beloved musical sensation by Tim Rice & Andrew Lloyd Weber reimagines the biblical story of Joseph, his father Jacob, eleven brothers and the coat of many colors. Told entirely through song and led by a powerhouse Narrator, Joseph includes iconic hits such as 'Any Dream Will Do,' 'Close Every Door' and 'Go Go Joseph.'

CHARACTER BREAKDOWNS THE PIRATES OF PENZANCE

THE PIRATE KING

Appearing Age 30-50 | Male | Vocal range: Baritone, G2 to G4

Swashbuckling, athletic, and handsome leader of The Pirates of Penzance. He would never really hurt anybody, especially not orphans as he and his band are all orphans themselves "and know what it is."

MABEL

Appearing Age 18-30 | Female | Vocal Range: Coloratura Soprano, C4 to C6

Mabel's top note in the production is Eb6. Young and beautiful, very much a young woman of the 19th century. She is genuine and utterly sincere as she captures the love of young Frederick. Her naivety and innocence make her a sweet and funny character.

FREDERIC

Appearing Age 18-30 | Male | Vocal Range: Tenor C3 to C5

Top note in the production is Bb5. Young, handsome and genuine. The feelings between Ruth, his nursery maid, and him are deep feelings, they care for each other on the most profound level. However, his feelings for Mabel are true love at first sight. He is funny because he is so sincerely trying to do the honorable thing; he truly is the "slave of duty", which is a running joke throughout the show, as well as the show's subtitle. For him, duty is before all.

MAJOR GENERAL STANLEY

Appearing Age 50-55 | Male | Vocal Range: Baritone G2 to G4

He is "dignified respectability," in the truest sense of those words. He is "vivid", with warmth and good humor. Quirky with military discipline, but believable.

NOTE: THIS ROLE HAS BEEN PRE-CAST

RUTH

Appearing Age 50-65 | Female | Vocal Range: Contralto, F3 to F5

She is a proper English nanny and has raised young Frederic "properly" to be a gentleman. It is from her that he has learned to be so polite and honorable and

to cherish respectability... and to give himself over wholly and completely to love. The feelings between Ruth and Frederic are the deep feelings of - almost - mother and son. They care for each other on the most profound level.

SERGEANT OF POLICE

Appearing Age 18-40 | Male | Vocal Range: Bass, F2 to F4

Obeys his duty and the law, but is a coward at heart. The choreography will call for a good dancer in addition to good vocal ability.

SAMUEL

Appearing Age 18-40 | Male | Vocal Range: Baritone, G2 to G4 The Pirate King's right hand man, he is sincere, earnest, and simple-minded.

EDITH

Appearing Age 18-30 | Female | Vocal Range: Soprano, C4 to C6 One of Major-General Stanley's daughters.

KATE

Appearing Age 18-30 | Female | Vocal Range: Mezzo-soprano, A4 to A6 One of Major-General Stanley's daughters.

ISABEL

Appearing Age 18-30 | Female | Vocal Range: Soprano, C4 to C6 One of Major-General Stanley's daughters.

CHORUS OF DAUGHTERS (3)

Appearing Age 18-30 | Female | Vocal Range: Contraltos (F3 to F5) & Sopranos (C4 to C6)

The more vivid and individual each daughter is, the better. Big voices are essential as there are more Pirates and Constables than daughters. Comedic understanding and moderate dance ability will be required.

CHORUS OF PIRATES

Appearing Age 18-40 | Male | Vocal Range: Baritones (G2 to G4) & Tenors (C3 to C5)

Simple minded, tender-hearted souls. Big, full-out singing is what is thrilling about the Pirates. The choreography calls for basic dance ability (including swords/fight choreography) in addition to strong vocal ability and a keen comedic sense.

CHORUS OF CONSTABLES

Appearing Age 18-40 | Male OR Female | Vocal Ranges: Various

They obey their duty and the law, but are cowards at heart. The choreography calls for strong movers in addition to good vocal ability and a keen comedic sense.

JOSEPH & THE AMAZING TECHNICOLOR DREAMCOAT

NARRATOR

Appearing Age 30-55 | Female | Ethnicity: Any | Vocal range: Soprano

The audience's guide through the story. The narrator tells Joseph's story with word and song. Can command the stage while directing focus to story elements. Strong singer with great energy! <u>**NOTE: THIS ROLE HAS BEEN PRE-CAST**</u>

JOSEPH

Appearing Age 18-30 | Male | Ethnicity: Any | Vocal Range: Tenor

Eleventh and favorite son of Jacob. Confident and charming. Vocally strong and captivating.

PHARAOH

Appearing Age 25-65 | Male OR Female | Ethnicity: Any | Vocal Range: Baritone or Mezzo

Egypt's ruler, considered a god on earth. Searching for the meaning behind his/ her dreams. Portrayed as a world-famous rock star. Full of energy and confidence. *May* also be cast as a member of the greater ensemble.

The Director has expressed interest in the possibility of casting a female Pharaoh. Female performers of all ethnicities strongly encouraged to audition

POTIPHAR

Appearing Age 25-50 | Male | Ethnicity: Any | Vocal Range: Baritone

Rich, self-indulgent, and sophisticated Egyptian capitalist. Makes Joseph the leader of his household. Strong character actor with a powerful speaking voice. *May* also be cast as a member of the greater ensemble.

MRS. POTIPHAR

Appearing Age 25-50 | Female | Ethnicity: Any | Vocal Range: Alto

Indulgent and confident in her pursuit of what she wants, which at this time happens to be Joseph. May also be cast as a member of the greater ensemble. Strong dancer necessary.

JACOB

Appearing Age 50-70 | Male | Ethnicity: Any | Vocal Range: Baritone

Aged father of Joseph and his 11 brothers. Strong character actor who can sing and move well.

BUTLER

Appearing Age 20-45 | Male OR Female | Ethnicity: Any | Voice: Tenor or Mezzo

Pharaoh's right hand. While in jail, Joseph interprets the Butler's dreams to a positive outcome. This role will be double cast as one of the brothers or wives.

BAKER

Appearing Age 20-45 | Male OR Female | Ethnicity: Any | Voice: Tenor or Mezzo

Head of Pharaoh's kitchen. While in jail, Joseph interprets the Baker's dreams to a less-than-positive outcome. This role will be double cast as one of the brothers or wives.

JOSEPH'S BROTHERS

Appearing Age 16-45 | Male | Ethnicity: ALL | Vocal Range: Various

Jealous of Joseph being their father's favorite son. Moderate to skilled dancers and singers. Will also double as general ensemble in some scenes (Ishmaelites, Egyptians, Canaanites, etc.)

WIVES

Appearing Age 16-45 | Female | Ethnicity: ALL | Vocal Range: Various

The 11 wives of Joseph's 11 brothers. Moderate to skilled dancers and singers. Will also double as general ensemble in some scenes (Ishmaelites, Egyptians, Canaanites, etc.)

CHILDREN'S CHORUS

Grades 2-6 (at the time of audition) | Male & Female | Ethnicity: ALL

An energetic and curious chorus of approximately 15-20 young performers (currently in Grades 2-6) to be featured in several musical numbers throughout the production. This group of young performers will be critical to the storytelling of 'Joseph.'
